Citadel Enterprises is Now an EPA Lead-Safe Certified Firm

MOUNT PLEASANT, S.C. – Citadel Enterprises has received its certification as an EPA Lead-Safe Firm. This means the company is now qualified to perform lead-safe renovations in homes that contain lead paint. The certification covers remodeling, repair and painting work in older houses, and in child occupied facilities.

In addition to the firm certification, several members of the Citadel Enterprises staff are now EPA Certified Remodelers. They include lead carpenters Jim Agnole, Ron Bureau and Walter “Skip” Skipper. This group attended a special training seminar where they learned how to safely renovate pre-1978 houses – specifically, how to prevent the dust from lead-based paint from harming adults and children.

Beginning on April 22, federal law required contractors to be certified and to use lead-safe work practices. That means pre-1978 homeowners should now ask their contractor for paperwork stating he is an EPA Certified Remodeler before any renovation work commences.
